Poverty Busters: PEP offering free income tax help

It's almost tax time again. The Salvation Army, Eastern Region II – Métis Nation, and the SaskTel Pioneers will once again be providing free income tax preparation services for individuals and families with modest incomes and simple tax returns.

To receive the GST/HST credit, Canada Child Benefit, and any other credits and transfer payments, individuals and families must file a return – even if they have no income. Those interested in taking advantage of this free service are asked to please bring their T4 and other tax information slips when coming to the income tax preparation clinics. Photo ID is also required.
